

**Covid Guidelines for groups using Zion Lutheran Church's building, in conjunction with CDC guidelines and IL Phase 5 state guidelines.**

1. Masks continue to be required for unvaccinated people. Masks are optional for vaccinated people. If children are present, we highly recommend, adults be masked as well. Groups may choose to set more stringent mask and distancing policies but may not set less stringent ones.
2. Groups may return to their original spaces (i.e. Tuesday night AA may return upstairs). The exception to this is that Saturday morning AA breakout groups will need to continue to stay on the lower level.
3. Indoor events should try to keep spacing reasonable and not overload capacity.
4. Any food brought in from the outside is encouraged to be individually wrapped. We continue to recommend people bring their own beverages, however AA may resume use of coffee pots (preferably their own if available). Please wipe these down well after use.
5. Continue to cleanup at the end of meetings. This includes:
  - a. Spray chairs at end of meetings (Bleach solution on hard surfaces. Lysol on fabric). Please let Deacon Marlene know if anything is getting low.
  - b. Sanitize bathrooms at end of meetings (if used)
  - c. Spray stair rails, door handles and lift components (if used)
  - d. Spray Lysol in the air.
  - e. Turn off air-conditioners or shut windows, whichever was used.
  - f. Turn off all lights – downstairs includes hallway lights.
6. Please continue to announce that people should stay home or they are not feeling well.
